## President's Message

2020 has already proven to be an interesting year. Due to the recent mandates by the State and County, we are not opening the Beach Club during Easter week (April 4-11) and cancelling the Easter Celebration at the club. We are not booking any private parties at the club through April and possibly May.

At the January annual board meeting, Chris Wade and I were reelected to the board. A total of five positions were up for election, so the board appointed Alison Anawalt, Nate Brown and Amanda Haynes to the remaining open positions. We want to thank Steve Elmer, Kurt Luebke and Frank Wilbur for their commitment to the board over the years. Their individual contributions to the club are appreciated by all of us.

We are excited to have Tracey Edwards as our new Beach Club Manager. Tracey and her family have been in Shorecliffs for over 23 years and she has always been involved in the club activities. Tracey will bring new energy and ideas to the beach club. And I would like to publically thank my husband, Jay Elston, for stepping into the interim Club Manager position for two months while we were recruiting for a new manager.

During our "off" season we have been making improvements to the Club. The beach club floors have been replaced with a commercial grade vinyl plank flooring product. The floors look like real wood, but are waterproof and scratch resistant. Other repairs/improvements to the club include a new sliding glass door, replacement of the foos ball handles and resurfacing of the shuffleboard court. Thank you Hal Kolp and Jay Elston for these improvements to our beach club.

We still have to find solutions to the rising tides, beach erosion and beach access issues. For this reason, the Board directed an increase in the annual dues to \$415 a year. The increase in dues will go directly to the reserve fund, not the operating fund, to build up money to pay for projects or studies to mitigate these problems.

Once we are able to gather together with our neighbors, let's bring the "Shorecliffs Aloha Spirit" to our Beach Club! Volunteer to help with the activities. Bring an appetizer to share to the Friday and Saturday night BBQ's. Join us on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of June, July, August and September for our new "band nights" when we will have music by local talents. Feed staff dinner or lunch if you have extra. Reach out to any board member if you have any ideas or suggestions. As Mr. Rogers says "it's a beautiful day in the neighborhood".

- We are providing disinfectant wipes for our staff and residents to clean the equipment they use.
- We're encouraging employees who are sick to stay home.
- We are educating employees on the signs and symptoms of COVID-19 and the precautions that can be taken to minimize the risk of contracting the virus.

#### **PRECAUTIONS TO TAKE:**

- CLEAN YOUR HANDS OFTEN -- wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after you have been in a public place
- •AVOID TOUCHING YOUR EYES, NOSE AND MOUTH WITH UNWASHED HANDS
- AVOID CLOSE CONTACT WITH PEOPLE the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommends a 6-ft distance between you and others
